Northern Hemisphere Gymnastics Behavioral Agreement

The purpose of this form is to ensure that each student has the best possible time at camp. We understand that some children may be unaware of all the rules, as a new student. What we ask is that children change their behavior when given corrections.

Classes and camps at Northern Hemisphere Gymnastics are very structured and disciplined. In order to provide the safest, most enjoyable experience possible, all students must be able to follow the behavioral rules and expectations below:

- Students must be able to follow directions from ALL coaches at Northern Hemisphere Gymnastics, even coaches who may be teaching other camps or classes at the time.
- Students must play well with others and use appropriate behavior at Northern Hemisphere Gymnastics.
- Students are expected to not behave in any way that would negatively impact the experience for other students at Northern Hemisphere Gymnastics.
- Students are expected to use our facility and the equipment we have properly, and in a safe manner so that they do not get injured, and so that the equipment isn't damaged or broken.
- Students are expected not to bully, or harass other students.
- If a student is feeling bothered by another student's words/actions etc., they should yell "STOP!" loudly so that a coach can see/hear the situation and respond to it immediately.

The management reserves the right to exclude any students who, in their absolute discretion are deemed to be in violation of these rules.

Failure to follow these rules could result in immediate expulsion from our program. Not all children possess the tools to follow these rules; our program may not be for everyone. Please give this a lot of consideration before entering into this contract.
